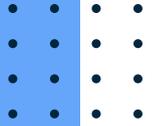

- Explore future collaborations between academia and industry

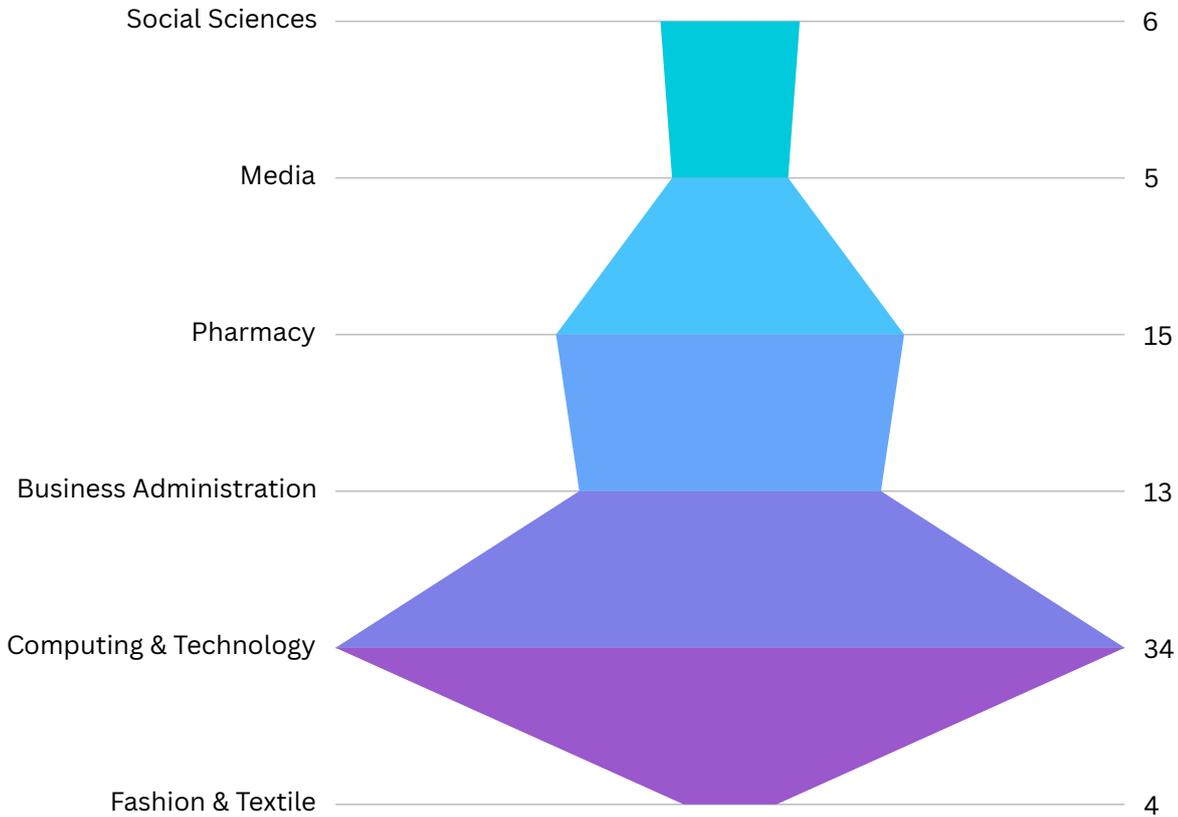
